

PETITION TO THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA

Whereas:

- The National Sex Offender Registry is currently only available to law enforcement agencies;
- Permitting public access to the National Sex Offender Registry is in the interest of greater public safety;
- The protection of children and vulnerable persons is a fundamental responsibility of the federal government;
- Access to accurate public safety information plays a critical role in preventing sexual offences and supporting community awareness;
- The absence of a publicly accessible federal sex offender registry has resulted in gaps in transparency and accountability; and
- The creation of a national standardized public registry subject to appropriate legal safeguards would promote consistency across jurisdictions and enhance public confidence.

We, the undersigned, **residents of Canada**, call upon the **Government of Canada** to amend the Sex Offender Information Registration Act (S.C. 2004, c. 10) to permit public access to the National Sex Offender Registry.
