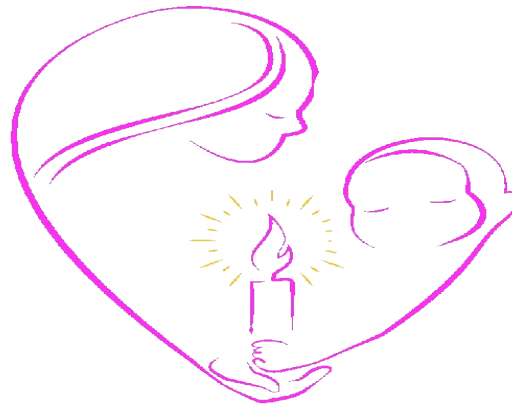
Join Mom's Resist

End Child Trafficking & Exploitation Now

Moms Resist exists to protect our most vulnerable – children – and the time to act is now. Every moment we wait puts them at risk

KEY OBJECTIVES:

1. Review of the Amber Alert system's strict criteria.
2. Call to amend Canadian laws to publicly identify child predators so that the public has access to the National Sex Offender Registry to enhance community safety.
3. Put child predators behind bars: Strengthen mandatory minimum penalties of imprisonment for predators who offend (including possession of child sexual abuse and exploitation material), and keep them imprisoned without bail to protect communities and prevent further public harm.
4. Human trafficking charges should be applied to all adult predators found with our missing children.
5. Demand criminal background checks for all teachers and staff at private schools.

The Staggering Reality

Recent statistics and reports reveal a deeply troubling trend in Canada:

- **THE "TIP" OF THE ICEBERG:** Police-reported human trafficking incidents have seen a general year-over-year increase. In 2023 alone, nearly 20,000 incidents of online child sexual exploitation were reported in Canada - a 59% increase from the previous year.
- **VULNERABLE YOUTH:** Approximately 22% of all trafficking victims in Canada are children and youth under the age of 18.
- **SYSTEMIC FAILURES:** Advocacy groups have highlighted that many high-profile networks of exploitation involved elite circles have operated with impunity for decades. While recent disclosures of international "files" have shocked the world, they only confirm what many survivors have been saying for years: exploitation reaches into the highest levels of society.
